Little Free Library's Impact Library Program places neighborhood book-sharing boxes in areas where books are scarce.

To date we have granted more than 1,500 Little Free Libraries full of books!

When children grow up in book-rich environments, literacy rates can skyrocket, especially for children living in low-income areas. In fact, access to books is cited as the number-one predictor of a child's ability to thrive in school.

But for many kids, books are hard to come by.

Two out of three children living in poverty have no books of their own. With your help, we can bring little libraries and books where they're needed most.

95% of Impact Program recipients agree their granted library is serving people who have little-to-no access to books elsewhere.

"Our Impact Little Free Library has been up in the courtyard of our school for a couple of months now. I refill it constantly, which is a great thing.


