# What Does a Little Free Library Steward Do?

**A Little Free Library steward is** an individual or group of people who care for a Little Free Library.

## **Basic Steward Responsibilities Include:**

- Attach your official Little Free Library charter sign to your library.
- Add your Little Free Library to the world map so your community can find it easily.
- Let your community know about this great new resource! Share the news of your library opening on social media, in a community newsletter, or with letters to your neighbors.
- Keep the library stocked with books.
- Perform regular maintenance to keep the library in good condition. Ensure the library is weatherproofed by caulking seams and adding weatherstripping if appropriate. Regularly check for pests around the library; a hornet nest, for example, would be an issue preventing visitors from safely sharing books.
